# Seven Inspiring Days

# FRIDAY - HAVE A GOAL

Think ahead. Visualize your future. Set your target. Design your strategy. <u>Plan before you start.</u> Be flexible in your tactics, but keep on track. Strive after your dreams, but stay realistic.

# SATURDAY – BE PROACTIVE
